## Missionary Minute

*"In 2004, Hurricane Ivan walked over the country of Grenada. Ninety percent of homes and most of the schools and offices were either destroyed or heavily damaged. I was asked by a friend to go down and give a hand and I did that. It was then that I came to know the joy of helping people in desperate need with a skill set that I feel God has given me. Since that time I have done about 13 missions (if I haven't forgotten any). Grenada was with Samaritan's Purse as were a number of domestic missions. Sandy and I did a domestic mission together as well as one year-long mission. The last five years I have been working with the Canadian Red Cross. Canada sends out an emergency hospital and my job is to erect it and/or maintain it. My work with them is within my skill set which is construction. When a disaster strikes, whether it be a quick onset like a hurricane, or slow onset like disease or famine, I get a call. I am on the rapid response roster which means I can be 'Wheels up,' as they say, in 48 hours. I mostly do disasters internationally as it seems hard to find people that are able or willing to go to tough spots. I feel God called me to this as it presses me closer to Him in the situations I find myself in. Of course, I much depend on the prayers of family and friends when sent out."-John Best*
